

# Cause and Effect Flip Charts

1. Students should fold their page in half long-ways.
2. Then open up the page and cut the "cause" and "effect" half up to the crease only.
3. Then they have two "doors"... one with the cause and one with the effect.
4. They need to fill in a logical cause or effect, depending on which is on their paper.
5. Then they will lift the "cause" door and draw a picture of the cause on the space underneath.
6. Last, they will lift the "effect" door and draw a picture of the effect on the space underneath.
